A key objective of our Livery is to support further education and training in the industry. This includes dedicated grants and funding that help individuals fulfil their career ambitions and encourage companies to provide an environment in which their employees can learn and develop.

Careers Without Limits

The building materials sector offers a diverse and widespread choice of rewarding job opportunities with qualifications, apprenticeships, mentoring or practical training to help individuals and teams start their journey or continue their development. Roles can range from drivers, yard operatives, operations and trade counter management through to sales, marketing, design, technical, IT, HR, finance and much more in-between!

WCoBMGmnts & Funding

Our grants of up to £2,000 each are for individuals or teams working with a building materials supplier or manufacturer. The grants are available to individuals looking to join our sector, current employees in the building materials sector who want to further their career, or companies who demonstrate how funding will be beneficial to the ongoing development of their teams. The grant, once approved, can be used to partially or fully support the following:

- The purchase of relevant materials that enable learning eg computer equipment, software or practical tools.
- Apprenticeship programmes.
- Dedicated qualifications, modules, training platforms or courses that are proven to contribute to further learning or development within the building materials sector.
- Dedicated work experience that allows for relevant training and new learning within the industry to support role development.

Other requests are considered on case-by-case basis.

- Students or Apprentices
- Employees working in the sector
- Employers: Builders' Merchants, Building Materials Stockists or Building Materials

Conditions/Criteria for applications

Students/Younger People:

• The applicant must not be in receipt of substantial income from their parents.

Apprentices:

- The apprentice must have at least 75% of their training still to be completed at the time of first application.
- A statement supporting the application must be received from the trainer/mentor or employer stating that the apprentice is progressing well and likely to complete the course in full.

Employees:

- Applicants are in employment with a builders' merchant, building materials stockist or building materials manufacturer
- Applicants must have worked in the industry for at least 12 months.
- There must be a demonstrable financial need indicating that the applicant cannot fund the course themselves.
- The course or training that the applicant is seeking financial support for must not be wholly available from the employer.
- Successful applicants must be prepared to sign a statement that they plan to remain within the industry for at least two years following completion of the course; otherwise they will agree to refund the cost of the Grant.

The Worshipful Company of Builders' Merchants will take a sympathetic view on all applications. If successful, the individual can benefit from one Grant only to the sum of £2,000. The same individual cannot re-apply for another Grant.

Exclusions: PLCs, multi-national or national organisations with firm financial stability or individuals that apply without explanation or demonstrable need.
