This Modern Slavery Policy outlines our commitment to ensuring that slavery and human trafficking are not taking place in any part of our Company.

Our Business:

The Worshipful Company of Builders' Merchants is a livery company whose object and intention is to encourage and foster means of professional and social intercourse and mutual information between those concerned with the business of builders' merchanting. We recognise the importance of conducting our business ethically and responsibly, and we are dedicated to respecting human rights and promoting fair labour practices.

Our Commitment:

1. **Policies and Procedures:** We have a policy to prevent modern slavery and human trafficking in all aspects of our organisation. This policy will be regularly reviewed and updated to ensure its effectiveness.
2. **Supplier Engagement:** We intend to actively engage with our suppliers to raise awareness of modern slavery issues and to encourage them to adopt responsible practices within their own operations and supply chains. We will provide our policy to our suppliers with a request that they endeavour to align their policies or ways of working to our policy.
3. **Employee Awareness:** We will ensure each employee has a copy of our policy to ensure awareness and understanding.

Our Future Steps:

The Worshipful Company of Builders' Merchants is committed to continuously improving our efforts to combat modern slavery. Our future steps include:

1. **Risk Assessment:** Conducting regular reviews to identify and address potential areas of vulnerability to modern slavery within our business and supply chain.
2. **Collaboration:** Collaborating with industry partners, government agencies, and non-governmental organisations to share best practices and contribute to collective efforts to eliminate modern slavery.
